Are you 12-30 years old and have you been diagnosed with cancer in the past year?

We need your help!

What:

Cancer treatment can affect young people's social wellbeing: friendships, education, work, etc. We want to better understand how and why that happens and what we can do about it. We're calling it the SOCIAL AYA Study.



Why:

We want to improve how young people's social wellbeing is supported during and after cancer treatment, so they can stay connected to those who matter to them.

How:

We'll ask you to answer a survey at 2 times: close to diagnosis and 6 months later. We'll also ask you to participate in an in-person interview after your first survey and a phone interview after your second survey to understand more about your experiences.
